Welcome to the class entitled "Education Change in a Global Era: A Theoretical Roadmap to Current Debates". This is Jeremy Rappleye. I am currently an associate professor at Kyoto University, but I used to be at Tokyo University, Graduate School of Education for about 4 years (doctoral research and post-doctoral position).

I am really looking forward to teaching you all. We have about 7 students registered for the class. I think it is the perfect size.

Please note there is a small mistake on the online version of the Course Schedule. *Our class will actually begin on Monday, January 21st (2nd period)*. We will have class on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday of that week. On Wednesday and Thursday you will have a break (=no class).

Importantly, I want you to begin reading for the class early. There are about 9-10 required articles for the class (plus another 2-3 that you should skim). This will take some time, so please start early. I suggest reading 2 articles each week in the 5 weeks between now and the beginning of class.
