Academic Calendar: Autumn semester: **31 August 2026 to 17 January 2027**
Spring semester: **18 January 2027 to 6 June 2027**

Examinations are arranged throughout the year with no fixed examination periods.

Language of Instruction: Swedish and English

Full Time Study Credits: Full-time studies during one term equals 30 credits. Courses normally contain 7.5, 15 or 30 credits. Students can choose four 7.5 credit courses or two 15 credits courses or any other combination. One week of full-time studies equals 1.5 credits. The workload is 40 hours per week, including lectures, readings, assignments, seminars, independent studies.
